

## Guidelines and Application Form 2007-2008 Bryng Bryngelson Research Funding Awards

### Overview:

Dr. Bryng Bryngelson (1892-1979) was a pioneer in communication sciences and disorders, especially in the area of stuttering, and he founded the speech clinic at the University of Minnesota in 1927. The Bryngelson Fund was established in honor of his many achievements, and is maintained only through individual donations.

The Department of Speech-Language-Hearing Sciences is pleased to announce that Speech-Language Pathology Students pursuing a Plan A Master's Degree are eligible for up to \$400 in expenses from the Bryngelson Research Fund to support their thesis research during the 2007-2008 academic year (Fall 2007; Spring and Summer 2008).

### Terms of Award:

Awards will be made in an amount up to \$400. Students applying for Bryngelson funds must provide a brief overview of their research and a budget (space is provided at the end of the application). Funds will be distributed at the time of the award. Only expenses that actually will be incurred are covered -- all receipts for expenditures must be submitted to Cathy de Ranitz in 215 Shevlin Hall.

### Number of Awards:

Plan A MA students may apply more than one time for support of the thesis; however, the total amount requested should not exceed \$400 and should only be for thesis-related expenses.

### Eligibility:

Active Plan A MA Speech-Language Pathology students in the Department of Speech-Language-Hearing Sciences.

### Examples of Allowable Expenses:

Subject payments or reinforcers, test protocols and other materials, mileage reimbursement for subjects, xeroxing, software, data storage, etc. Travel to attend workshops/conferences, etc. typically would *not* be allowed.

### Review Process:

The Department Chair, Dr. Jennifer Windsor, will review applications. Applications will be accepted throughout the academic year. The application should be discussed with the student's thesis advisor prior to sending the application.

### Selection Criteria:

Applications will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

- The thesis project has an approved IRB if it involves human subjects.
- The likelihood that the thesis will result in a national presentation or publication.
- If requests exceed Bryngelson resources, priority will be given to students without other sources of funding for the completion of the thesis. department chair.
